The organization provided 10,082 direct service hours to our supported organizations. These services included accounting, database management, general administrative support, strategy management, and fund development support. These services provided backoffice efficiencies and tools allowing supported organizations to focus their time and resources on achieving their stated mission. One hundred sixteen (116) nonprofit agencies were served. Supported organizations benefitted from SKC's sharing of it's resources such as the free use of two conference rooms.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 15,162 including grants of \$ 0) (Revenue \$ 6,100)
The organization promotes "best practices" for nonprofits in the community. Each year we award the Excellence in Nonprofit Leadership awards. The nomination and awards process educates board and staff leadership about the importance of governance, oversight, and transparency. In addition to direct client services, the SKC staff met one-on-one with 49 organizations seeking guidance and resources about best practices for nonprofits. The SKC staff presented 8 workshops on governance and fiscal management. Utilized scholarship funds in support of leadership development for our clients.

The organization acted as fiscal agent on behalf of the Healthcare Foundation of Greater Kansas City for 15 agencies. The agencies indirectly benefitted from SKC's financial statement audit on which a clean opinion was issued.
